

Complete a transition profile

Objective(s)

Learners will discover the process of developing a transition profile.

Description

In this activity, learners will review a case scenario and complete a transition plan to support the child and family's transition process.

Detailed Facilitator Instructions

1. Have learners review the handouts.
2. Have learners complete Handout 2.1: Child Transition Profile for a child they are already working with or an example child.
3. Provide feedback.

- Break into groups to discuss and respond.
- Invite guest panel members to discuss developing a transition plan from their perspectives (via teleconference, on-site or through an online discussion).
- Give learners example scenarios of children with disabilities to use as an example.
